### Explanatory notes:

- All bonus and penalty payments are based on manufacturing milk.
- VAT rate changed from 5.4% to 5.6% as per Budget 2021.
- Arrabawn pay a 0.2c/l bonus on all milk with an SCC less than 200,000.
- Aurivo have a milk storage bonus which is available to suppliers with a minimum annual supply of 160,000L that have enough refrigerated storage capacity to cover seven milking's at peak production; Aurivo also have a 0.22c/L protein bonus available for every 0.05% protein achieved, above the co-op average protein %, in an individual month.
- Carbery Group pay a bonus of 0.5c/L from March to October and a 0.88c/L bonus from November to February to suppliers who achieve a somatic cell count (SCC) of less than 200,000.
- Carbery Group is still paying 1c/L from its stability fund, which is included in its A and B price.
- Dairygold apply no penalties to total bacteria counts (TBCs) of less than 75,001 in the months of January, February, November, and December. Penalties will apply to TBCs more than 75,000 in those months.
- Dairygold have a 0.25c/L included and 0.1c/L for the Sustainable Dairy Assurance Scheme (SDAS), 0.1c/L for sign up to milk recording (four per year) and 0.05c/L for sign up to milk recording and a Munster Bovine herd health scheme; Dairygold also have a 0.04c/L maximum bonus attainable by farmers who achieve the minimum requirements for six criteria (TBC, thermoduric, sediment, SCC, lactose and inhibitors); This is cumulatively amounts to 0.69c/l.
- Dairygold are also paying a 3c/l early calving bonus to all members that meet the quality criteria.
- Glanbia include 0.42c/L payment on all milk supplied as a 'Share of GI Profit'. Glanbia are also paying a 4c/l seasonality bonus to all members for January milk.
- Kerry pays 0.4c/l bonus on all milk with an SCC less than 200,000.

- Lakeland pays 5c/L bonus on January milk if more than 45% of May milk production for milk supplied in January. Lakeland also continued a 1c/L flat bonus payment for January milk.
- North Cork pay 0.1cpl bonus on all milk with an SCC of less than 200,000. North Cork are paying 0.5c/l bonus on all January milk.
- Strathroy pay 0.25cpl bonus on all milk with an SCC of less than 200,000. Strathroy also pay 0.25cpl bonus on all milk with an TBC of less than 10,000.
- Tipperary pay a bonus of 0.25c/l on all milk with an SCC less than 250,000 and pay a 3c/L bonus for January Milk if more than 10% of May milk production was supplied in January.
